The Articles of Incorporation for Drs. Blass, Blass & Weinstein P.C. respectfully show:

1.

The name of the corporation shall be DRS. BLASS, BLASS & WEINSTEIN P.C.

2.

The period of duration shall be perpetual.

3.

The corporation is organized under the Georgia Business Corporation Code and elects to become subject to the Georgia Professional Corporation Act.
