ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
ATLANTIC TAPE COMPANY, INC.

The petition of WILLIAM R. LAWRIKORE of 205 Twiggs Corner,

Warrington Place, College Park, Georgia 30349 respectfully
shows:

1.

Petitioners desire to be Incorporated as provided by the
Laws of Georgia, under the name style of:

"ATLANTIC TAPE COMPANY, INC."

2.

Said Corporation shall have perpetual existance as provided
under the Georgia Business Corporation Code.

3.

The object of said Corporation is pecuniary gain and profit.

4.

The Corporation shall be empowered to carry on any lawful
business activity. Without limiting the generality of the
foregoing, the primary nature of the Corporation's business to
be transacted is to engage in the business of owning, maintain-
ing and operating industrial and household tape manufacturing
and sales facilities in all of its phases, including, without
being limited to, buying, selling, leasing, renting, maintain-
ing, using, operating, installing and distributing of all

materials, equipment and personal property appurtenance or incident to and useful in the business of operating tape manufacturing and sales facilities, and to purchase, own, hold, convey and otherwise use and enjoy real and personal property of all kinds for the operation of the aforesaid business, and in connection therewith, to acquire, construct, maintain, and operate buildings and equipment deemed necessary or convenient therewith;

To engage in such other lawful business or venture that is not unlawful under the Laws of the State of Georgia or those of the United States of America.

5.

The Corporation shall be authorized to issue not more than TWENTY FIVE THOUSAND (25,000) shares of Common stock having a PAR VALUE of TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00).

6.

The Corporation shall not commence business until it shall have received not less than ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00) in payment for the issuance of stock.

7.

The address of the initial registered office of said Corporation shall be at 4975 Clark Howell Highway, Building 2G, College Park, ^{Clayton} Georgia 30349, and the name of the initial registered agent at such address shall be WILLIAM R. LAWRI-MORE.

8.

The initial Board of Directors shall be WILLIAM R. LAWRI-MORE of 205 Twiggs Corner, Peachtree City, Georgia 30269 and ROY G. CHAPMAN of 5333 Warrington Place, College Park, Georgia 30349.

9.

The capital stock of the Corporation may be issued for money, property or other things of value, or a combination of the same.

10.

The Corporation shall have the power to invest Corporate assets for the benefit of the Corporation's employees, including, but not limited to, the principals of the Corporation, which benefits are allowable to Corporations in general under the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, as other applicable statutes.

11.

The Corporation shall have the power to provide by its By-Laws, such restrictions on the transfer of stock upon the death of a shareholder, or in respect of any transfer whatever, as is deemed suitable for the best management of the Corporation.

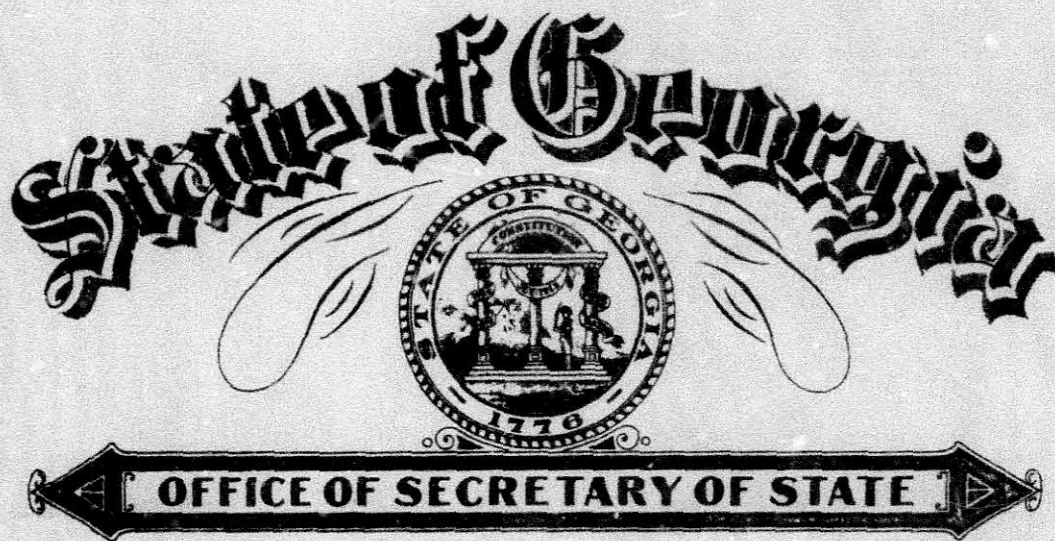
