ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

"DANELLE CORPORATION"

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation is DANELLE CORPORATION.

ARTICLE TWO

The corporation is organized pursuant to the provisions of the Georgia Business Corporation Code.

ARTICLE THREE

The term of the corporation is perpetual..

ARTICLE FOUR

The purpose for which this corporation is organized is for profit and the corporation shall have all the general powers contained in Georgia Code Section 22-202, and all subsections thereof and more particularly shall have the power to purchase, take, receive by gift, will or otherwise, lease, or otherwise acquire own, hold, improve, repair, use and otherwise deal in and with real or personal property, to operate a Heating and Air Conditioning business including installation and repairs.

ARTICLE FIVE

The initial registered agent of the corporation is D. B. Hubbard. The address of the registered agent is 250 Westview Place, S. W., *Fulton* Atlanta, Georgia 30314.

ARTICLE SIX

The aggregate number of shares which the corporation has authority to issue is 1,000,000, all of which shall be common shares with a par value of \$5.00.

ARTICLE SEVEN

The amount of capital with which the corporation will begin business is \$500.00.




