- A. The period of duration for the Company is perpetual, unless dissolved by the members.
- B. The Company is formed to conduct business for any lawful purpose.

- D. The Company is governed by a written Operating Agreement executed by its initial members.
- E. The Company agrees to indemnify and hold harmless any member or manager or other person from and against any and all claims and demands whatsoever arising in connection with the limited liability company to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- F. All action to be taken by the Company requires a 51% vote by the members for approval, and no party has the right to act as agent for or to bind the Company in the absence of such approval. Other restrictions and limitations on the ability of any party to bind the Company are set forth in the Operating Agreement.
- G. Acts not apparently for the carrying on in the usual way of business does not bind the Company unless authorized in accordance with the Company's written operating agreement.
