Spreading and sharing of the Gospel, and teaching, training, empowering people to make a personal relationship with God and grow their Christian faith; 7. Putting people Christian faith into action through charitable and humanitarian, and educational activities (such as providing food, clothing, shelter, and so on) that serve as a tangible example of God's love in ways that can also improve the quality of life, both spiritual and practical, of those in need. Article 3 3.01 Nonprofit Nature The corporation is a nonprofit corporation organized pursuant to the provisions of the Georgia Nonprofit Corporation code (O.C.G.A. 14-3-202).

Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, the purposes of the corporation are exclusively limited to exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. No part of the net earnings of Kendi & Kenda Foundation, Inc. shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purposes herein. 3.02 Activity Not Allowed No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall be for the purpose of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. None of the activities of this corporation shall consist of participation in, or intervening in any political campaign (including publishing or distributing statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.
