ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
CONTINENTAL AMERICAN METAL PRODUCTS COMPANY, INC.

I.

The name of the corporation is: CONTINENTAL AMERICAN METAL PRODUCTS COMPANY, INC.

II.

The corporation shall have perpetual duration.

III.

The object of the corporation is pecuniary gain, and the purposes for which the corporation is organized are as follows:

The general nature of the business to be conducted shall be that of manufacturers representative and broker for various principals engaged in the building material supply business, and otherwise to deal generally in any business related thereto or connected therewith; to buy, process, manufacture, service, sell and trade in property of all kinds, whether real, personal or intangible; and to have all the powers presently granted to corporations by law and all powers which shall in the future be granted to corporations by law without limitation by reason of the powers specifically enumerated herein.

IV.

The corporation shall have authority to issue not more than 500,000 shares of common stock of \$1.00 par value per share.

V.

The corporation shall not commence business until it shall have received not less than Two thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) in payment for the issuance of shares of stock.

VI.

The initial registered office of the corporation shall be Peachtree-DeKalb Airport Building 35-A, Chamblee, (DeKalb), Georgia. The initial registered agent of the corporation shall be Arnold Fleeman.
