ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
ATLANTA ROD & MANUFACTURING, INC.

I.

The name of the corporation is "Atlanta Rod & Manufacturing, Inc."

II.

The corporation is organized pursuant to the provisions of the Georgia Business Corporation Code.

III.

The corporation shall have perpetual duration.

IV.

The corporation is a corporation for profit and is organized for the following purposes: to distribute and manufacture metal goods, to engage in any lawful business or activities related thereto; and to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under the Georgia Corporation Code.

V.

The corporation shall have authority, acting by its board of directors, to issue not more than 100,000 shares of a common class having a par value of \$1.00.

VI.

The corporation shall not commence business until it shall have received consideration of not less than \$500.00 in value for the issuance of its shares.

VII.

The shareholders of the corporation shall not have any preemptive rights to acquire any unissued shares of the corporation.

VIII.


