ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

GREATER MACON EDUCATIONAL FUND, INC.

I.

The name of the corporation is: Greater Macon Educational Fund, Inc.

II.

The corporation is organized pursuant to the provisions of the Georgia Nonprofit Corporation Code.

III.

The corporation is organized for the following purposes:

(a) To provide educational services to the citizens of the Greater Macon area in order to promote their growth and development as citizens of the community by presenting, sponsoring or promoting public discussion groups, forums, panels, lectures, speakers or other similar programs or by providing books, pamphlets, or other educational materials on whatever topics will accomplish that purpose, including but not limited to such topics as the national, state, county and city governments and their subsidiary and related bodies, boards or organizations; the various units of the civil and criminal justice system; the public school system; individual growth and development; organizations devoted to and means of promoting industrial development and growth in the community; charitable and service organizations in the community; the housing industry; and, the health care industry. All of the foregoing shall be done in a manner consistent with §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

(b) The corporation is not organized and shall not be operated for pecuniary gain or profit. No part of the

property of the corporation and no part of its net earnings shall inure to the benefit of any director or any other private individual. The corporation shall never be authorized to engage in a regular business of a kind ordinarily carried on for profit or in any other activity except in furtherance of the purposes stated above for which the corporation is organized.

(c) In the event of the dissolution of this corporation, to the extent allowed under applicable law, all of the assets of the corporation shall be distributed to or its assets shall be sold and the proceeds distributed to, another organization organized and operating for the same purposes for which this corporation is organized and operating or to one or more corporations, funds or foundations organized and operating exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary or educational purposes, which shall be selected by the Board of Directors of the corporation. Provided, however, that any such recipient organization or organizations shall at that time qualify as exempt from taxation under the provisions of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or the corresponding provisions of any subsequent law. In the event that for any reason upon the dissolution of the corporation the Board of Directors of the corporation shall fail to act in the manner herein provided within a reasonable time, the senior Judge of the Superior Court of Bibb County shall make such distribution as herein provided upon the application of one or more persons having a real interest in the corporation or its assets.

(d) To do any and all acts and things necessary, convenient, expedient, ancillary or in aid to the accomplishment of the foregoing; to do any and all acts and things permitted by the Georgia Nonprofit Corporation Code, provided that no part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution

of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

(e) Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation will not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

IV.

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors. The method of election of directors shall be as determined by the By-Laws of the corporation.

V.

The initial registered office of the corporation is 577 Mulberry Street, Macon, Bibb County, Georgia 31201. The initial registered agent of the corporation is Walter H. Bush, Jr., and his written consent to such appointment is attached to these Articles of Incorporation.

VI.

The initial Board of Directors shall consist of twelve members, who shall be:

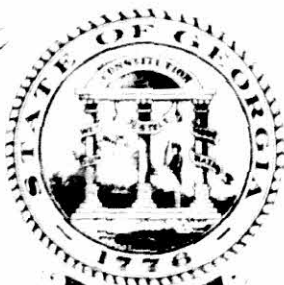

A meeting of the members of Greater Macon Educational Fund, Inc., was held on August 25, 1982. There were 12 members present and eligible to vote and 12 voted in favor of the plan of merger.

3.

The only member of Georgia State Fair Association, Inc., eligible to vote on the merger is The Greater Macon Chamber of Commerce, Inc. The Greater Macon Chamber of Commerce, Inc., has consented to the merger in writing, said consent being attached hereto as Exhibit B.

4.

The effective date and time of the merger shall be the time of delivery of the Articles of Merger to the Georgia Secretary of State.

1.

The names of the merging corporations are Greater Macon Educational Fund, Inc., and Georgia State Fair Association, Inc. The name of the surviving corporation shall be Greater Macon Educational Fund, Inc.

2.

The terms and conditions of the proposed merger are as follows:

(a) All of the assets of Georgia State Fair Association, Inc., will be transferred to the surviving corporation;

(b) The surviving corporation shall assume all of the liabilities of Georgia State Fair Association, Inc., and in particular that certain contract between Georgia State Fair Association, Inc., and Macon Exchange Club Fair Association, Inc., dated March 8, 1982.

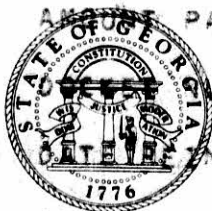
