ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

I.

The name of the corporation is "B & L
WRECKER SERVICE, INC."

II.

The corporation is organized pursuant to the
provisions of the Georgia Business Corporation Code.

III.

The corporation shall have perpetual duration.

IV.

The corporation is a corporation for profit
and is organized for the following purposes: Engage in
the operation of a wrecker service for the towing
of wrecked, disabled, illegally parked automative
vehicles or the freeing of automobiles stalled in snow
or mud; to store such vehicles; to dispose of vehicles
at public auctions in accordance with state regulations,
and to engage in any lawful business or activities
related thereto; and to engage in any lawful activity
for which corporations may be organized under the
Georgia Corporation Code.

V.

The corporation shall have authority, acting
by its board of directors, to issue not more than 5,000
shares of a common class having a no par value.

VI.

The coporation shall not commence business
until it shall have received consideration of not less
than \$500.00 in value for the issuance of its shares.

VII.

The shareholders of the corporation shall have preemptive rights to acquire any unissued shares of the corporation.

VIII.

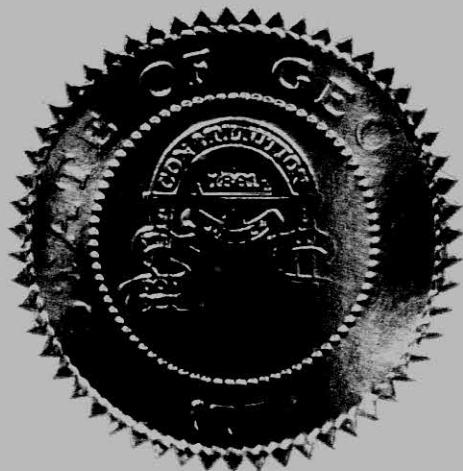
