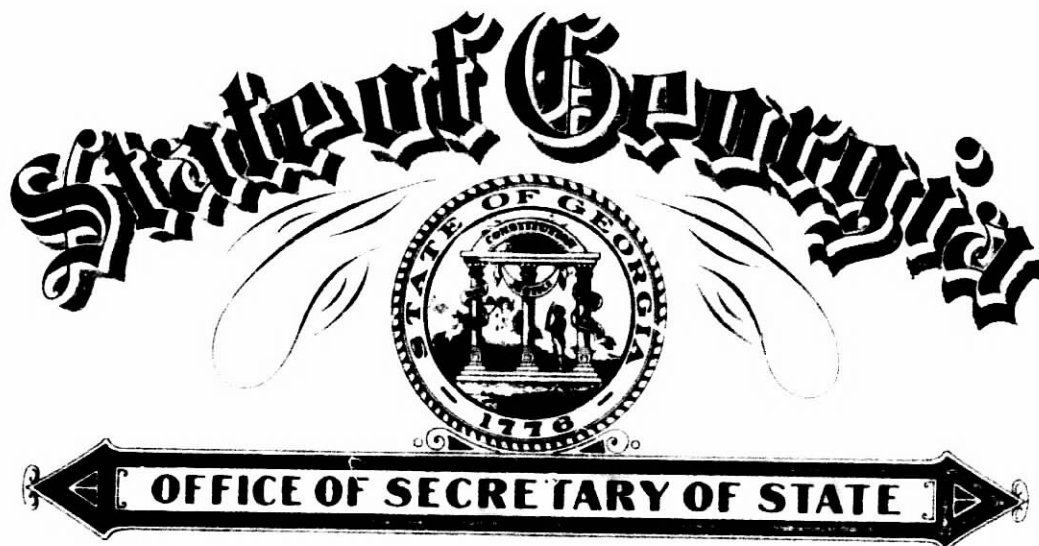

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
CHANDLER INTERIORS, INC.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is:
CHANDLER INTERIORS, INC.

ARTICLE II

The corporation shall have perpetual duration.

ARTICLE III

The corporation is organized pursuant to the provisions of the Georgia Business Corporation Code for the purpose of conducting any and all business in the State of Georgia. The corporation is organized more particularly for the purpose of the sales and installation of acoustical ceiling and drywall, including materials and labor, on a sub-contractor basis.

The foregoing statement of specific purposes shall be liberally construed and shall not be interpreted so as to limit in any manner the aforesaid general powers, but rather shall be interpreted to be in furtherance of and in addition to the general powers.

ARTICLE IV

The corporation shall have the authority, acting by its Board of Directors, to issue not more than Ten Thousand (10,000) shares of common stock of no par value.

ARTICLE V

The corporation will not commence doing business until capital in the amount of at least Five Hundred and no/100 (\$500.00) Dollars have been received.

ARTICLE VI

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed

by the Officers and Board of Directors of said corporation
as set forth in the By-laws of said corporation.

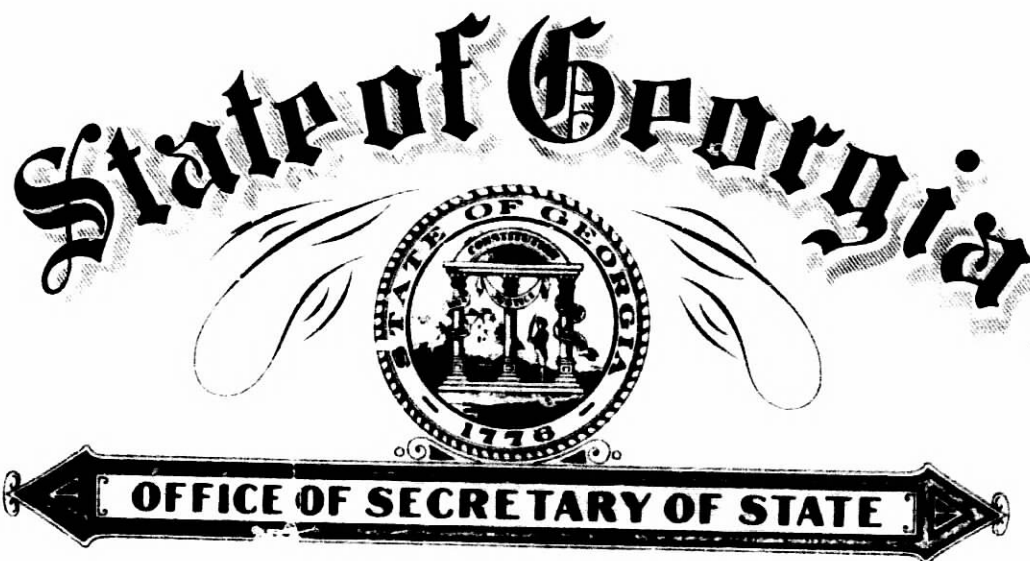
