ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

I.

The name of the corporation will be:

The corporation shall have authority to issue not more than 2500 shares of common stock of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars par value.

The corporation shall not commence business until it shall have received not less than \$500.00 in payment for the issuance of shares of stock.



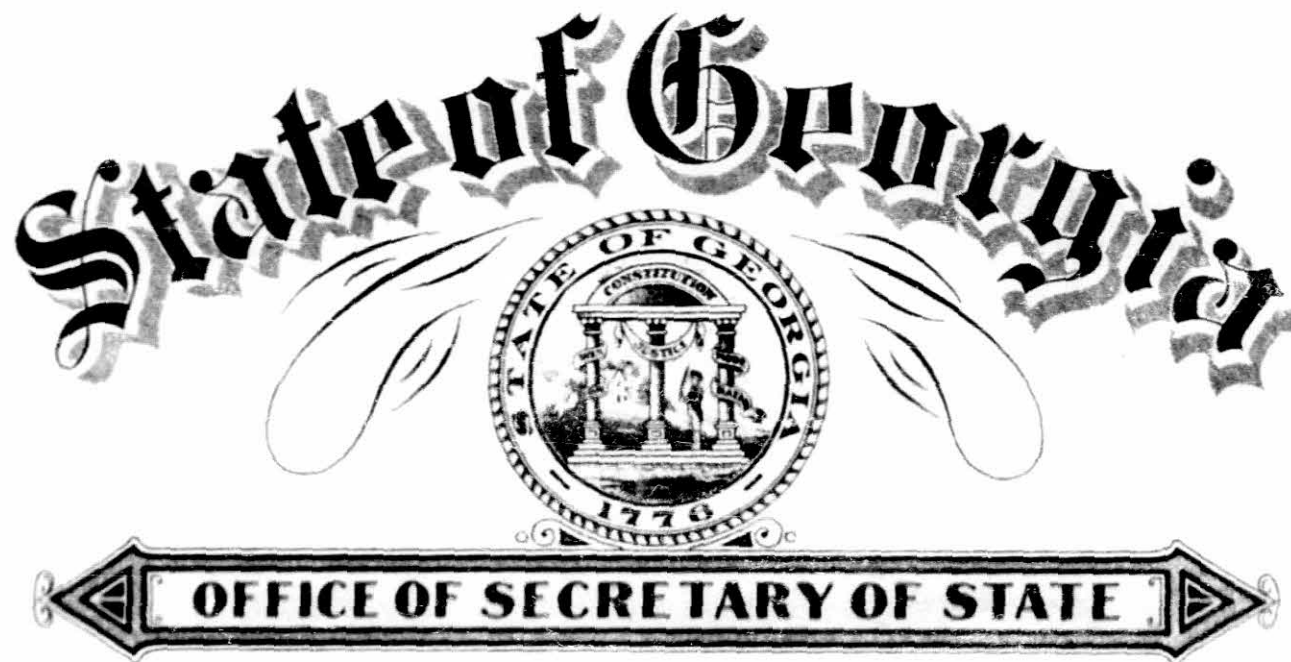

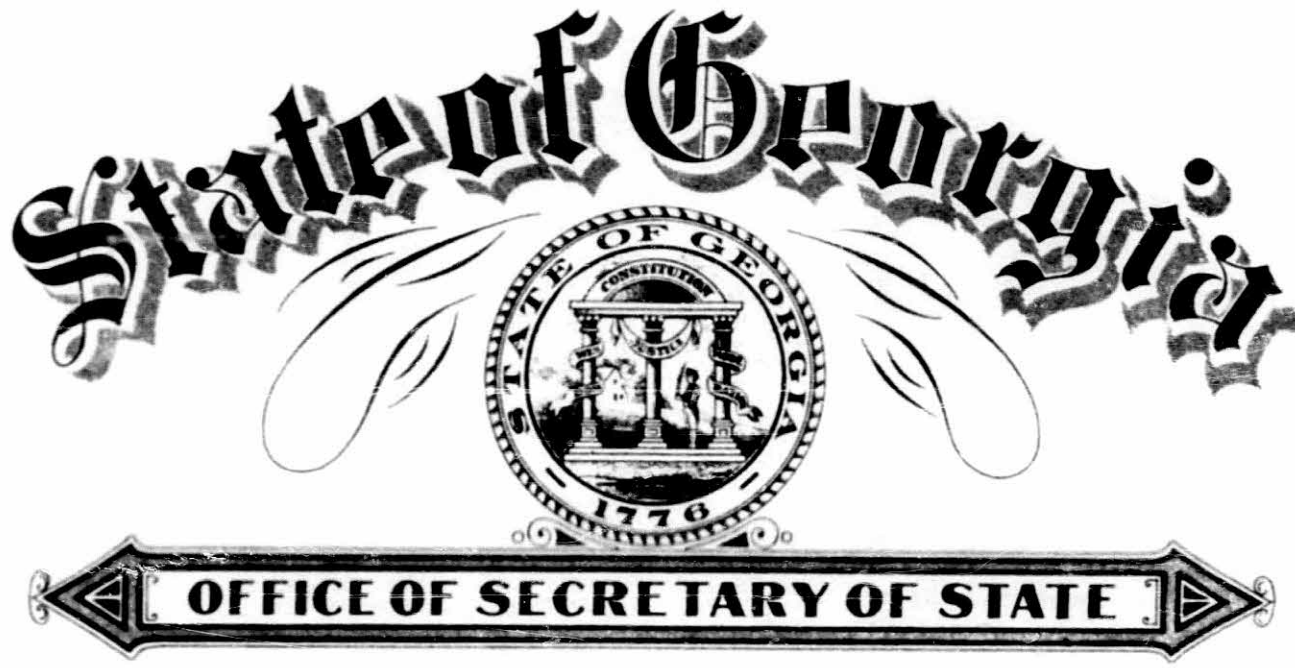
