ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
GAINESVILLE RADIOLOGY GROUP, P.C.

I.

The name of the corporation is:
GAINESVILLE RADIOLOGY GROUP, P.C.

II.

The corporation shall have perpetual duration.

III.

The corporation is organized under the Georgia Business Corporation Code and hereby elects to become subject to the Georgia Professional Corporation Act, Ga. Laws, 1970, No. 943, P. 243, for the following purposes:

To engage in every phase and aspect of the business of rendering the same professional services to the public that a Doctor of Medicine, duly licensed under the laws of the State of Georgia, is authorized to render, but such professional services shall be rendered only through officers, employees, and agents who are duly licensed under the laws of the State of Georgia to practice medicine within this State.

To own real and personal property necessary or appropriate for the rendering of the professional services authorized by this Article and to invest the funds of this Corporation in real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds, or any

other type of investment whatsoever.

To do all and everything necessary and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attaining of any of the objects or the furtherance of the purposes and objects enumerated in these Articles of Incorporation or any amendment thereof, necessary or incidental to the protection and benefit of this Corporation, and, in general, either alone or in association with other associations, corporations, firms, or individuals, to carry on any lawful pursuit necessary or incidental to the accomplishment of the purposes or the attainment of the objects or the furtherance of such purposes or objects of this Corporation; and to enter into any other lawful businesses from time to time, without limitation.

IV.

The corporation shall have authority to issue not more than 100,000 shares of common stock of One Dollar (\$1.00) par value.

V.

The corporation shall not commence business until it shall have received not less than \$500.00 in payment for the issuance of shares of stock.

VI.

The initial registered office of the corporation shall be at Hall County Hospital, Radiology Department, Gainesville,

Georgia. The initial registered agent of the corporation shall be DR. W. CLARK FERRELL.

VII.

The initial Board of Directors shall consist of 2 members who shall be:





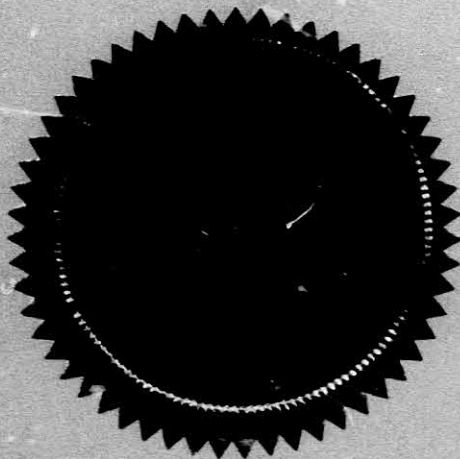
