ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
"PLASTIC MATERIALS FOR INDUSTRY, INC."

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation is "PLASTIC MATERIALS FOR INDUSTRY, INC."

ARTICLE II

The Corporation shall have perpetual duration.

ARTICLE III

The Corporation is organized pursuant to the provisions of the Georgia Business Corporation Code.

ARTICLE IV

The Corporation is a corporation for profit and is organized for the following general purposes:

(a) To engage in the sales of plastic resins and related products to the molding and fabrication community.

(b) To engage in any lawful business activity relating thereto.

(c) To engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under the Georgia Business Corporation Code.

ARTICLE V

The corporation shall be authorized to issue its common

stock in accordance with the provisions of Section 1244 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, pursuant to such prior plans as it may from time to time adopt, and the Board of Directors of the corporation shall be authorized to adopt the initial plan for the issuance of such common stock at its first organizational meeting.

ARTICLE VI

The maximum number of shares of capital stock that the corporation shall be authorized to have outstanding at any time shall be 1,000,000 shares of common stock of the par value of \$10.00 per share; and the corporation shall not begin business until it has received consideration of a fixed value, which shall not be less than \$500.00, for the issuance of its shares of common stock.

ARTICLE VII

The Board of Directors of the corporation may authorize the issuance of bonds, debentures, and other evidences of indebtedness of the corporation and may fix all the terms thereof, including, without limitation, the convertibility thereof into shares of stock of the corporation of any class or any series of the same class.

ARTICLE VIII

The initial registered office of the corporation shall be 734 Seminole Place, Marietta, Cobb County, Georgia 30062, and the initial registered agent of the corporation at said address shall be WILLIAM N. CHESTER.

ARTICLE IX

The initial Board of Directors of the corporation shall consist of one member, whose name and address is as follows:



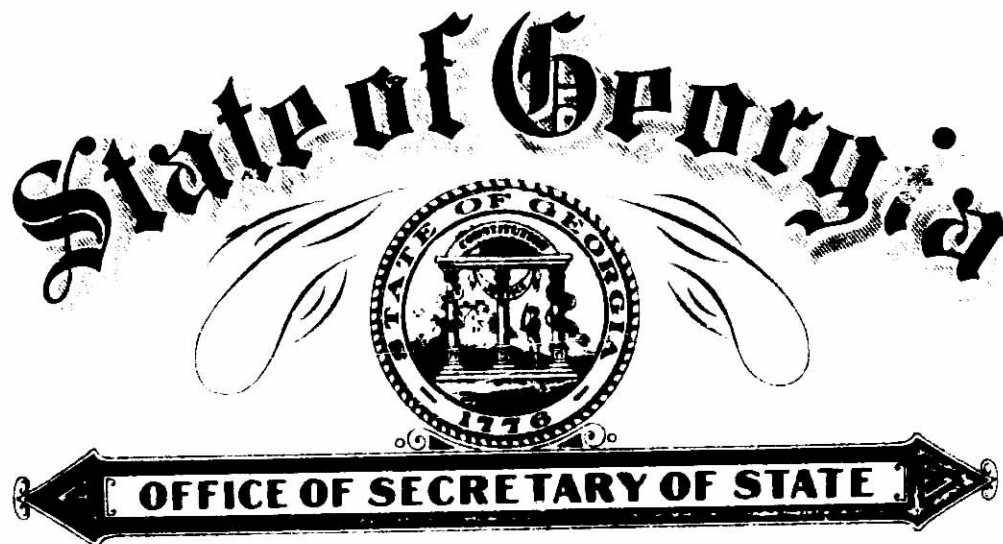
